Following a 17-day stay with our experienced therapy team, Gail no longer needed his wheelchair and was able to walk 825 feet with a two wheeled walker with good safety awareness. He was able to reach his goals of needing minimal assistance for upper and lower extremity dressing, toileting transfers and bathing.
